Today, the Illinois State Police is a multifaceted police agency enforcing the laws, protecting the public, and providing an array of specialty services to other law enforcement agencies.

REQUIREMENTS:

All applicants must have a valid driver's license, proof of U.S. citizenship and no felony convictions.

OPTION I

- Bachelor's Degree

OPTION II

- Applicants must have an Associates of Applied Science in Law Enforcement, an Associate of Science Degree, or 60 semester/90 quarter hours core course work.
- Applicants must also have completed 3 years of continuous full-time service as a police officer with the same police agency or 3 years of consecutive active military duty.

OPTION III

- Applicants with an honorable discharge status including a service war campaign medal (see website for listing).
