

September through November 2011 Training Schedule

The Illinois Uniform Crime Reporting (I-UCR) Program reporting guidelines were revised and went into effect January 2010 as announced through numerous direct communications to law enforcement agencies as well as being posted on the I-UCR website. Over 400 agencies have not yet attended training, and 250 agencies have not submitted data on the modified forms or applied the revised guidelines. This data cannot be accepted, and must be re-submitted by December 14, 2011, using the appropriate forms and guidelines which can be found at the bottom of the I-UCR website. Training has been conducted throughout the state to assist agencies in transitioning to the revised guidelines. Training dates and locations are listed below. Agencies are limited to two attendees per class; however, additional registrations can be submitted to be placed on a waiting list in the event of cancellations. One registration form (found in the I-UCR Program Forms and Reporting Guidelines section at the bottom of the web page) must be completed for each attendee and faxed to 217/524-8850. Confirmation with additional information regarding the training will be e-mailed to each attendee. The class begins promptly at 9:00 a.m. with a one-hour break for lunch, and concludes at approximately 3:00 p.m. The training includes instruction on index crimes, supplemental data (domestic incidents, crimes against children, attacks against school personnel), hate crime, LEOKA, homicide supplemental reporting, and electronic reporting. There is no cost for the training. The revised program is federally compliant, as required for application to JAG grant funding; however, if data submitted does not conform to the revised guidelines, it will not be forwarded to the federal program.
